GUIDELINES FOR PASSPORT RENEWAL

Application for Renewal of Mauritius Passport Form (P.F 136A) to be used and can be downloaded at: http://passport.govmu.org/English/Documents/PF136A-2014(EDITABLE).pdf

Your attention is drawn to the following:

- (a) This form is used where a person applies for the renewal of his/her Mauritius passport which has expired or is completely filled with stamps, and no change in his/her name, marital status or citizenship since he made his/her last application for a passport.
- **(b)** Every applicant should comply with paragraph 4 of the form and shall submit such other documents as the Passport Officer may require.
- (c) The Application Form should be duly filled-in and signed with a felt pen 0.6 mm in black ink only. The signature or thumbprint should be inside the box without touching the borders. (If applicant cannot sign, the right thumbprint should be affixed in the presence of a Diplomatic Staff / Honorary Consul of Mauritius in the country of residence) and forwarded to the Embassy of Mauritius, with the below-mentioned documents in original as well as two sets of photocopies thereof.
